

Dormant and Orphan Site Nomination Portal

Quick Reference Guide



Getting Started

A few things to note when using the Dormant and Orphan Site Nomination Portal:

- Nomination of a site puts it forward for priority consideration in the Dormant Sites Reclamation Program funding. There is no guarantee that it will receive funding through this program or that the amount of funding will be adequate to fully restore the site.
- The number of nominations a site receives will not determine whether it receives funding.
- Additional sites may be added to the portal throughout the nomination period; the data is updated daily.
- While all attempts have been made to ensure all sites are represented in the portal, there may be a small number of sites without location data.

Navigation

As you navigate the map, Dormant and Orphan Sites available for nomination visible within the current map view are listed on the right hand side of the Portal. You can navigate to your area of interest in the following ways:



- Use the **Zoom In** and **Zoom Out** buttons located in the top left of the map. You can also click on the **Home** button to return to the default view of the map.

- Pan, zoom and navigate the map using your keyboard controls, mouse or touchscreen




- If you're using a location enabled device, you can navigate to your current location using the **Find My Location** icon

- Use the **Find address or place** tool in the top left of the map view by:
 - entering a physical address or place name (*ex: 6534 Airport Rd*)
 - entering the name of an Indigenous Community (*ex. Doig River*)
 - entering a portion of the dormant or orphan site name (*ex. CNRL*)

Selecting a Site for Nomination

1. Click the site on the map or select the site from the list. Once selected, the site name, well number and proponent are listed.

2. To nominate this site, click the **Add a comment** button  which will open a list of questions to answer as part of the site nomination process.


3. Once all required questions have been answered, click Submit.

4. To return to the list of sites after submission, click the back icon.
