RE: Warning: Fail To Comply With Condition Of An Authorization

Dear Mr. Chramosta,

Shell Canada Limited (Shell) holds an authorization issued under the Water Sustainability Act. Each authorization contains a standard condition as follows:

The permit holder must maintain accurate records of all water withdrawal activities throughout the term approved. Water withdrawal records for each diversion point, including "0" values for months where no water was withdrawn, must be recorded monthly. Water withdrawal records must be submitted to the Commission on a quarterly basis via eSubmission. Quarterly reports are due on or before April 25th, July 25th, October 25th, and January 25th.

This condition provides the company three weeks to compile its water withdrawal data and to submit a report to the Oil and Gas Commission (Commission). A report for AD 100109813, WU 5493, for the months of July, August and September was due no later than October 25, 2020.

On October 26, 2020 the Commission received the required report, 1 day past the due date.

Shell has no history of late water withdrawal reporting so given the circumstances Shell is hereby issued a warning only for the following:

Shell, on or about October 26, 2020, at or near Fort St. John, in the Province of BC, did fail to comply with the condition of an authorization contrary to Section 106(3)(k) of the Water Sustainability Act.
