RE: APPROVAL FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION
TALISMAN W STODDART 03-15-86-21 W6M; WA# 17951

The Commission has reviewed your application dated September 16, 2005 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Upper and Lower North Pine zones in the subject well.

The Commission designates the gas pools under application to be the Stoddart West – North Pine "E" (upper zone) and Bear Flat "G" (lower zone). Both pools contain sweet gas at similar pressure and have been mapped as single well entities.

Both zones indicated some depletion following deliverability testing, the Bear Flat zone especially showing evidence of limited reserves. Liquid loading issues have preventing segregated production. Commingled production is expected to allow production, thereby accessing recoverable reserves. The production string has been configured with a sliding sleeve, which will allow segregation of the two zones if required.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these zones is hereby granted approval, under the authority of Section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the North Pine (1451.0 1453.0 mKB) and Bear Flat (1467.0 1468.0 mKB) formations may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, water and condensate production should be allocated on the Ministry of Small Business and Revenue BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of North Pine 50% and Bear Flat 50%. The allocation factors may be amended to reflect results of any future tests.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
