

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 29, 1976, requesting interim approval of concurrent gas production from the well d-43-I/94-A-15 at 2MMscf/D for a period of six months.

Your request is approved effective September 1, 1976 and will terminate after six months. It is hoped that within this time period compression facilities will be installed for gas conservation at the oil well d-33-I/94-A-15. The Branch must be advised prior to implementation of the Concurrent production schemes as outlined in the approval letter of April 30, 1976.
