IN THE MATTER of a Concurrent Production scheme of Poco Petroleums Ltd. (Poco) for producing Montney Halfway "D" and "H" Pools with a project oil and gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to section 113 of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Act, hereby approves the Concurrent Production scheme of Poco for oil and gas production with project allowables, as such scheme is described in:

(a) Application from Poco to the Division dated August 31, 1992, and related submission.

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

- 1. The area of the project shall consist of sections 1-87-19 W6M.
- 2. The project oil allowables, being the sum of individual well allowables, is $61.7 \text{ m}^3/\text{d}$.
- 3. Gas production from the project will be limited to 25 E^3m^3/d .
- 4. All gas production will be conserved.
- 5. Approval 92-06-002 is rescinded.
- 6. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
