Application for Concurrent Production Remington et al N Pine 14-13-85-18W6 North Pine - North Pine 'B'

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated 1986 09 29 requesting concurrent production approval for the subject well.

A concurrent production scheme under Good Engineering Practice for Section 13-85-18W6 was granted to Kildonan Oil Limited on 1978 12 05. As the Remington et al N Pine 14-13-85-18W6 oil well is located within this area, your application to join the existing scheme is approved. Accordingly, conditions 2 and 3 of the Branch approval of 1978 12 05 are hereby modified to read as follows:

- 2. Daily oil allowable restrictions are removed.
- 3. The daily gas allowable for the area is  $60.0 \cdot 10^3 \text{m}^3/\text{d}$ , however, gas production from the well 14-13 is limited to  $14.1 \cdot 10^3 \text{m}^3/\text{d}$ .
