RE: Modification to Concurrent Production Scheme Flatrock - Halfway 'E' Pool

This refers to your application dated December 9, 1991, requesting a daily oil allowable for the well Wainoco Flatrock 14-14-84-17 (W.A.# 6375).

A concurrent production scheme was approved for sections 17 and 18-84-16 and sections 13 and 14-84-17, effective October 16, 1978, with amendments in 1981 and 1984. The subject of a proposed well being drilled in the 14-14-84-17 location was addressed by the Ministry in a letter dated March 20, 1984, see copy attached.

In order to clarify the conditions of this concurrent production scheme, following the numerous revisions, they are listed as follows:
