Dear Mr. Clement:

Re: Application for Good Engineering Practice Sukunka Baldonnel "E" Pool

This refers to your GEP application dated February 11, 1988, and other correspondence dated June 6, 1988, requesting a modified approval for the subject single well pool. The modified approval for a smaller GEP area was proposed by us in a letter dated May 20, 1988 and was conditional on written concurrence from all partners.

As written concurrence for the proposal has been received from Ocelot Industries Limited, the only partner in the project, the application is approved under Division 77 of the British Columbia Drilling and Production Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- The area of GEP consists of Units 14, 15, 24, 25, 34-37, 44-47, 54-47 and 64-67, Block J/93-P-4.
- 2. The daily gas allowable for the area is $959 \cdot 10^3 \text{m}^3/\text{d}$. This is based on a gas-in-place estimate of $5 \cdot 000 \cdot 10^6 \text{m}^3$ and recovery factor of 70%.
- 3. The Division must be notified if the producing water-gas ratio rises above 30 $\rm{m}^3/10^3\rm{m}^3$ (5.3 Bbls/MMSCF).
