IN THE MATTER of a Good Engineering Practice (GEP) scheme of Dekalb Energy Canada Ltd. (Dekalb) for producing Peejay West Halfway "D" Pool with a project oil allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to Part 8, Division 6, section 104 of the <u>Drilling and Production</u>
Regulation, hereby approves the GEP scheme of Dekalb for oil production with project allowable, as such scheme is described in

(a) Application from Dekalb to the Division dated March 12, 1993.

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

- 1. The area of the scheme shall consist of units 22 and 23 of Block G/94-A-15.
- 2. The project oil allowable is 22.6 m³/d which is the sum of the individual allowables.
- 3. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
