THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT DRILLING AND PRODUCTION REGULATION MINISTRY OF ENERGY, MINES AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES ENERGY RESOURCES DIVISION

IN THE MATTER of a revision to the Good Engineering Practice (GEP) scheme of Mobil Oil Canada (Mobil) for producing Sahtaneh Slave Point "B" Pool with an increase in the project gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to Part 8, Division 6, section 104 of the <u>Drilling and Production</u>
Regulation, hereby approves a revision to the GEP scheme allowable of Mobil, as such scheme is described in

an Application from Mobil to the Division dated July 6, 1994 and related submission.

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and in particular:

- 1. The area of the scheme shall consist of units 74-77, 84-87, 96 and 97 of Block J/94-I-12 and units 6 and 7 of Block B/94-I-13.
- 2. The project gas allowable is $535 E^3m^3/d$.
- 3. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
