As no written objections were received by October 6, 1977 the application is approved subject to the following conditions:


1. The GEP area is the same as the Project area.
(93, 94, 95-G and 3, 4, 5, 14, & 15-J/94-A-15).
2. The oil allowable for the GEP area is 130 BOPD.
3. Gas production from the GEP area will be limited to 0.5 MMSCF/D.
4. Gas production will be conserved.
5. The effective date of this approval will be the date the Branch is advised of completion of the gas conservation facilities.
6. This approval may be modified or rescinded at any time if deemed necessary by the Chief of Branch.
