GOOD ENGINEERING PRACTICE AREA KOBES - HALFWAY

An approval to produce Halfway gas wells within the Kobes field under Good Engineering Practice (GEP) was granted to Pacific Petroleum Ltd. on April 1, 1966.

A recent review of the land holdings in the Kobes field indicates that the assigned GEP area does not conform with the leases currently held by Petro-Canada. Accordingly, the area of the Petro-Canada operated GEP for the Kobes Halfway "A" pool has been revised and is described as follows:

94-B-8: Block I, units 72, 73, 82, 83 and 92-95 94-B-9: Block A, units 2-5, 14, 15, 24, 25, 34, 35, 44 and 45
