The Ministry has reviewed your letter of March 10, 1997, detailing the annual voidage replacement calculations as required for the subject GEP scheme.

As a condition of this GEP approval, water is injected into a common aquifer by Anderson Exploration Ltd. within the Eagle West Unit #1 on behalf of Rigel Oil & Gas Ltd. The declining production GOR indicates good pressure support. We agree that water volumes in excess of voidage replacement for this GEP have accumulated over the 1996 calendar year. Injection on behalf of the subject GEP may cease until production voidage balances with the accumulated injection volume. Details of these calculations are required following the present calendar year.
