Re: Application for Good Engineering Practice
Stoddart West-Artex 'A' Pool

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated June 4, 1988, requesting approval of a Good Engineering Practice (GEP) area in the subject pool with oil production to be exempted from GOR penalties.

The Ministry's geological and engineering interpretation is very similar to the one presented by your company. The oil pool is considered to be of limited areal extent and, at this time, only the Al6-21-85-20 W6 oil well is completed in this pool. Due to high GOR penalties, the well cannot be produced economically. Therefore, this application will be treated as a concurrent production scheme with good engineering practice.

As written responses were submitted from the operators of adjacent developed land indicating that they have no objection to the proposal, your application is hereby approved under Division 77 of the B.C. Drilling and Production Regulations subject to the following conditions.

- 1. The area of concurrent production and Good Engineering Practice is N 1/2 Section 21-85-20 W6.
- 2. The oil allowable for the well is $10 \text{ m}^3/\text{d}$.

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- 3. Gas production from the area will be limited to $14.1 \ 10^3 \text{m}^3/\text{d}$.
- Gas production will be conserved.

5. The effective date of the approval will be the date the Division is advised of completion of gas conservation facilities.

6. The approval is subject to periodic review and may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate due to a change in circumstances.

Please note that the previously approved daily oil allowable for the well has been kept unchanged. Accordingly, another well drilled in the GEP area will also qualify for an oil allowable.
