## PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT DRILLING AND PRODUCTION REGULATION THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA MINISTRY OF ENERGY, MINES AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES ENERGY RESOURCES DIVISION

IN THE MATTER of a Good Engineering Practice (GEP) scheme of Summit Resources Limited (Summit) for producing a portion of the Wildmint Halfway "A" Pool gas cap with a project gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to Part 8, Division 6, section 104 of the <u>Drilling and Production</u>
Regulation, hereby approves the GEP scheme of Summit for gas production with a project gas allowable, as such scheme is described in

an Application from Summit to the Division dated November 18, 1994, and related submission.

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

- 1. The area of the project shall consist of units 94, 95 of Block A/94-H-2, units 4, 5, 14, 15, 24, 25, 34, 35, 44 and 45 of Block H/94-H-2.
- 2. The reserves based project gas allowable is 77.2 e3 m3/d.
- 3. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
