RE: CONCURRENT PRODUCTION SCHEME MODIFICATION ELM HALFWAY "C" POOL

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated November 8, 1993, requesting modifications to the concurrent production scheme approval of September 12, 1990, for the subject pool.

We concur with you that Elm Halfway "C" pool consists of a single oil well which has been on production since 1986. As the underlying acquifer is providing some pressure support, the oil rates have stabilized whereas the producing GOR's have decreased from a high of 10,000 m³/m³ to around 200 m³/m³. In view of this, restricting this single well pool to it's daily oil allowable is now considered unnecessary. Consequently, we wish to advise that condition #2 of the concurrent production approval of September 12, 1990, is hereby modified as follows:

2. The well within the project area may be produced without daily oil allowable restrictions.

All other conditions of the approval remain unchanged.
