RE: CONCURRENT PRODUCTION APPROVAL, AMENDMENT #1 RIGEL – HALFWAY "C" POOL

Commission staff have reviewed your application, dated March 31, 2008, to amend the Concurrent Production approval granted December 21, 2007 for a portion of the Rigel field Halfway "C" pool gascap. This amendment is specific to allowing production from the well Pavilion Talisman Rigel c 40-L/94-A-9.

Approval 07-07-010 (Amendment #1) is hereby granted under Section 97 of the <u>Petroleum and Natural Gas Act</u>. This approval permits controlled production of the gascap wells c-40-L/94-A-9 (WA# 4957) and A6-33-88-16 (WA# 23360).

The other operator in this pool, Canadian Natural Resources Limited, did not object to this amendment application following notice on the Commission website, or when contacted directly. Significant reservoir pressure differences were observed in wells in this pool during recent tests. This apparent poor communication, and "water-fence" isolating a portion of the gas cap production from the oil wells, should allow opportunity to capture remaining recoverable reserves. Restricted gas production will continue to support existing infrastructure.

As the well A6-33 is completed outside of the gas target area, individual well production is limited to a penalized daily gas allowable of $4.1 \text{ e}^3\text{m}^3$.

Please note that the project allowable may be amended if gascap withdrawl is observed to be having an adverse impact on remaining pool oil recovery.

APPROVAL 07-07-010 (Amendment #1)

THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT OIL AND GAS COMMISSION

IN THE MATTER of a Concurrent Production scheme of Pavilion Energy Corp. (Pavilion) for producing gascap gas from the Rigel Halfway "C" pool with a project gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to Section 97 of the <u>Petroleum and Natural Gas Act</u>, hereby amends a Concurrent Production scheme of Pavilion for gas production with project allowable, as such scheme is described in

an Application to the Commission dated October 4, 2007 and March 31, 2008 and related submissions.

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

1. The area of the scheme shall consist of:

Twp 88 Rge 16 W6M - SE/4 Sect 32 & Fractional NE/4 Sect 32 - SW/4 Sect 33 & Fractional NW/4 Sect 33 94-A-9 Block L - Fractional Units 20 and Units 30, 40, 50 94-A-10 Block I - Fractional Units 11 and Units 21, 31 and 41.

2. A project daily gas allowable of 26.6 10³m³ may be produced from the following wells:

Pavilion Talisman Rigel c-40-L/94-A-9 (WA# 4957) Pavilion Rigel A6-33-88-16 (WA# 23360)

- 3. The well A6-33-88-16 is restricted to an individual well daily gas allowable of $4.1 ext{ } 10^3 ext{m}^3$.
- 4. All produced gas must be conserved.
- 5. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
