## Asset Inspections due to Severe Weather

Based on the recent severe weather occurring in the North and South Peace River areas of British Columbia, the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) is recommending all B.C. oil and gas operators inspect their well facilities and pipelines to ensure the integrity of these assets is maintained, particularly in areas prone to erosion.

The operational and structural integrity of some assets may potentially be a concern due to the several areas impacted by significant rainfall and water flow. Activity in some areas may be limited at this time due to access problems created by weather. The Commission encourages operators to evaluate integrity and ensure operational safety as conditions permit.

Incidents of damage to assets due to extreme weather should be reported to the Commission through the regular incident reporting procedures.
