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IN THE MATTER of a scheme of Summit Resources Limited (Summit) for Salt Water Disposal (SWD) in the Slave Point formation in the well Summit et al E. Kotcho a-5-J/94-I-14 (WA# 3747).

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Part 8, Division 3, section 97 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, the SWD scheme is hereby approved, as such scheme is described in

*an application from Summit to the Division dated November 20, 1997.*

1. The water disposal interval must be in the Slave Point formation.
2. A record of volume of salt water disposed of through this well must be included on a Monthly Injection/Disposal Statement, in the prescribed form, which should be submitted to the Energy and Minerals Division not later than the 25th day of the month following the reported month.
3. The disposal/injection pressure at the sandface must not exceed the formation fracture pressure.
4. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
