IN THE MATTER of a scheme of Talisman Energy Inc. (the "Operator") for Salt Water Disposal (SWD) in the Pardonet-Baldonnel Formation in the well Talisman Sukunka b-65-B/93-P-5.

The Minister of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, pursuant to section 116 of the Act, hereby orders as follows:

1. The SWD scheme of the Operator for disposal of produced water in the Pardonet-Baldonnel Formation at well b-65-B/93-P-5 as such scheme is described in the application from the Operator to the ministry dated September 26, 1994, is hereby approved, subject to terms and conditions herein contained.
2. The water disposal interval must be in the Pardonet-Baldonnel Formation.
3. A record of volume of salt water disposed of through this well must be included on a Monthly Injection/Disposal Statement, in the prescribed form, which should be submitted to the Energy Resources Division not later than the 25th day of the month following the reported month.
4. The well head disposal/injection pressure must not exceed the formation fracture pressure.
5. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
