Re: Water Disposal, Cdn Res Quintana Pac Kotcho c-44-H/94-I-14

Notice of your application dated November 24, 1975 to dispose of Bluesky and Slave Point waters from the Kotcho East Field into the Slave Point formation in the well Cdn Res Quintana Pac Kotcho c-44-H/94-I-14 was published on December 4th and 11th, 1975 in the British Columbia Gazette.

As no written objections were received by December 25th, 1975 the application is approved effective December 29, 1975 subject to the following conditions:

- 1) After commencement of water disposal samples of the Bluesky and Slave Point waters must be taken and subjected to compatibility tests. Results of these tests are to be forwarded to our District Engineer at Fort St. John B.C.
- 2) This approval may be modified or rescinded at any time.
