The Commission has received the report for groundwater monitoring well installation and sampling at disposal well site Predator Oil BC Thetlaandoa c-24-L/94-P-06 (WA 13463), dated March 29, 2018, prepared by Matrix Solutions Inc. for ObsMobil Inc. OpsMobil is operating the well on behalf of the permit holder.

Approval for disposal of produced water, OGAA Section 75 Order 01-02-012 Amendment #2, was issued for the subject well on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017. Requirements under this order included a groundwater monitoring program outlined in Appendix A.
