As part of B.C.'s efforts to achieve equivalency with federal methane emission reduction regulations, the BC Oil and Gas Commission (Commission) has introduced a new [Public Request for Investigation Form](#). The form supports recent amendments to Part 5, Division 3.1, Public Requests for Investigation under the Oil and Gas Activities Act, the new [Investigations Regulation](#), and enhances the Commission's existing regulatory framework governing methane emissions.
