Area #2

94-O-15 Block A – units 31-33, 41-43, 51-53, 61-63, 71-73, 81-83
94-O-16 Block D – units 38-40, 48-50, 58-60, 68-70, 80, and 90

If no valid objection in writing is received by the undersigned by December 23, 2008 the application may be approved subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.
