## RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION PC Beg a-54-F/94-G-1; WA# 13022

The Commission has reviewed your application dated October 12, 2001 requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Baldonnel and Halfway zones encountered in the subject well.

The Commission has designated the gas pools under application to be the Beg – Baldonnel "B" and Halfway "A". Both pools contain gas with similar reservoir pressures and gas compositions. Commingled completion would offer an economic ability to produce gas from both pools, thereby increasing gas recovery.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two pools is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Baldonnel (1510.0-1531.0 mKB) and Halfway (1774.0-1780.0 mKB) zones may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Baldonnel 35 % and Halfway 65%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
