Re: Disposal of Produced Water from b-75-F/94-J-7

This refers to your application of April 13, 1972 concerning the disposal of produced water from the Slave Point formation of the subject well into the Mississippian formation through the well d-83-1/94-J-10.

*Debolt*

Approval of the request is granted, subject to the condition that the produced water-gas ratio does not exceed 2 BW/100SCF. Any increment in the water-gas ratio will indicate production of Slave Point formation water which is incompatible with formation water in the Mississippian. Therefore, if this limit of 2 BW/100SCF is exceeded, an analysis of the produced water will be required together with details of plans for continued disposal.
