
Re: Application for Good Engineering Practice

Notice of your application for Good Engineering Practice from the Belloy formation for the well Scurry CanPlac Eagle 6-34-84-18 W6 was published on May 12 and May 19, 1977 in the British Columbia Gazette.

As no written objections were received by June 3, 1977 the application is approved, subject to the following conditions:

1. The GEP area is section 34-84-18 W6.
2. The oil allowable for the GEP area is 70 BOPD.
3. Gas production from the area will be limited to 1 MMSCF/D.
4. Gas production will be conserved.
5. The effective date of this approval will be the date of completion of gas conservation facilities. (July 78)
6. This approval may be modified or rescinded at any time if deemed necessary by the Chief of Branch.
