RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION CNRL PEEJAY a-58-H/94-A-15; WA# 8459

The Commission has reviewed your application dated December 6, 2000, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Gething and Boundary Lake zones encountered in the subject well.

The Commission has designated these single well pools as the Peejay – Gething "H" and Boundary Lake "A". Both zones contain sweet gas at similar reservoir pressure. Any potential crossflow should have no detrimental effect on gas recoveries. Commingled completion would appear to offer an economic ability to produce marginal zones, thereby increasing reserves recovery.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Gething (1034.0–1038.0 mKB) and Boundary Lake (1108.0–1109.0 mKB) zones may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Gething 95% and Boundary Lake 5%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
