RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION CNRES PEEJAY d-A93-E/94-A-16; WA# 11967

The Commission has reviewed your application dated February 14, 2000, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Gething and Nordegg zones encountered in the subject well.

The Commission has designated the gas pools encountered by this well to be Peejay - Nordegg-Baldonnel "A" and the single well Gething "I".

Both zones contain mainly sweet gas, estimated current reservoir pressures are approximately equal. Any potential crossflow should have no detrimental effect on other producing wells. Commingled completion would appear to offer an economic ability to produce marginal zones, thereby increasing reserves recovery.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two pools is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Gething (1007.0 1021.0 mKB) and the Nordegg-Baldonnel (1031.3 1032.6 mKB) zones may be commingled.
- 2. Gas and condensate production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Gething 65% and Nordegg-Baldonnel 35%. Water production should be allocated Gething 20% and Nordegg-Baldonnel 80%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
