RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION ENCAL ET AL OAK 11-32-86-18 W6M; WA# 8354

The Commission has reviewed your application dated May 15, 2000, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Buick Creek and Baldonnel zones encountered in the subject well.

The Commission designates these gas pools in the Oak field to be the single well Gething "D" and the Baldonnel "F".

Both zones contain gas at similar pressure, crossflow should not be an issue for these pools. Commingled completion would appear to offer an economic ability to produce marginal zones, thereby increasing reserves recovery.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two pools is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Gething (1080.5 1085.5 mKB) and the Baldonnel (1167.0 –1181.0 mKB) zones may be commingled.
- 2. Gas and condensate production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Gething 25% and Baldonnel 75%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
