RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION PARA BERKLEY TATTOO b-25-L/94-O-10; WA# 13243

The Commission has reviewed your application dated April 27, 2001, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the two Mattson pools encountered in the subject well.

The Commission has designated these pools as the Mattson "C" and Mattson "D". Gas from these pools is expected to be of similar composition and pressure. Commingled completion would appear to offer an economic ability to produce marginal zones, thereby increasing reserves recovery.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production is hereby approved, under the authority of section 41 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Mattson "C" (498.5–500.1 mKB) and Mattson "D" (454.3–487.4 mKB) pools may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the Ministry of Energy and Mines BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Mattson "C" 20% and Mattson "D" 80%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
