This acknowledges receipt of your application dated August 19, 1991 requesting permission to commingle production from the Bluesky and Dunlevy Formations in the subject wells.

We wish to advise you that your application is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

## Penn West Buick A10-22-88-19 W6M: Was 7507

- 1. Production from the Bluesky perforations at 1082.5-1088.5 mKB and the Dunlevy perforations at 1114-1124 mKB may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated to the formations on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Bluesky 65% and Dunlevy 35%.

## Penn West Buick 11-23-88-19 W6M: 4: 7435

1. Production from the Bluesky perforations at 1073.7-1080 mKB and the Dunlevy perforations at 1102-1119.5 mKB may be commingled.

2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated to the formations on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Bluesky 35% and Dunlevy 65%.

The approvals may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in cicumstances.
