Dear Mr. Rowley:

Regarding your application of February 12, 1991 requesting approval to commingle production from the Nordegg, Pardonet and Baldonnel Formations in the subject well.

We wish to advise you that the Division will recognise the Pardonet and Baldonnel Formations in this well as one zone, the Pardonet-Baldonnel with Pool Code 4060, for reserves and production reporting, provided that the proposed pressure tests confirm pressure continuity. Based on our analysis of the logs it appears that there may be Nordegg pay in the well bore. However, it is questionable whether this Nordegg is productive in the well. If pressure tests confirm continuity, all pay in the well would be assigned to the Pardonet- Baldonnel.

Please submit the test results and your analysis of the test at your earliest.
